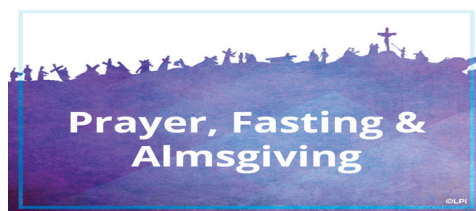

FATHER ANTHONY'S FAITH FORMATION CORNER

The Story of Lazarus (John 11) and the Power of God's Love

An incident that I would much rather forget, but cannot, took place on Sunday night, June 24, 2018. I was in my last days at St. Barbara's Church before my transfer to Our Lady Queen of Angels parish (Newport Beach) in July. I received a call for the anointing of the sick for a patient at Fountain Valley Hospital. I have always been good at taking care of these hospital visits. But that night, I failed to do so in a timely manner; and the patient died! The family was very frustrated—understandably so.

This 5th Sunday of Lent gives us the beautiful story of the raising of Lazarus (John 11). We are told that Jesus is friends with Mary, Martha and Lazarus, and that he loves them. Yet when he hears that Lazarus is sick, he seems indifferent: waiting for two more days until making his visit. When he finally arrives, the poor man had been in the tomb a few days already! One can only imagine the anguish, anger, frustration, and all the negative emotions felt by Martha and Mary. Why the delay? Is Jesus not a good friend after all? Does he want Lazarus dead so he can show off his power to raise his friend from the dead? I shall come back to that question later.

THE "I AM" STATEMENTS IN ST. JOHN'S GOSPEL: What does Jesus himself have to say about death? At least from this Gospel story... probably not much! Rather, he makes the bold claim: "I AM the resurrection and the life," both of which are clearly antitheses of death. This is one of the famous seven "I am" statements in John's Gospel: *I am the bread come down from heaven, I am the light of the world, I am the good shepherd, I am the gate for the sheep, I am the resurrection and the life, I am the way the truth and the life, and I am the vine.*

This "I am" saying is not just any ordinary one, but has had a rich history in the biblical traditions. In the account of the encounter between God and Moses (Exodus 3) at the burning bush, young Moses asks God: "What is your name," in case the Egyptians ask for the name of the god who sent him. In antiquity, there were many gods/goddesses. By posing the question "*What is your name,*" Moses means to say: *What kind of god are you, so I can distinguish you from the other gods?* Furthermore, to know someone's name means that you have some control or preconceived knowledge of that person—as in the case of parents giving their children certain names... As we know, God would not play these games with Moses. He does not say: "I am this or that god," or "my name is so and so." Rather, God says: "I AM WHO AM." That is the translation of the biblical Greek *Ego Eimi*. I believe that both ancient and medieval philosophy understood that statement to mean that God "exists in himself." John the Evangelist, or the person who wrote the Gospel, uses that exact same expression in reference to Jesus. Thus, all those "I am" statements by Jesus in John's Gospel do carry a great deal of weight when it comes to his (Jesus') divinity.

Among those seven "I am" sayings, the most important one can be found in this Lazarus account. In fact, for the early Church, belief in the resurrection was at the core of their faith. The early Christians proclaimed, above all else, that God raised Jesus from the dead. St. Paul famously said that if Christ had not risen from the dead, our faith would be in vain (1 Cor 15). And yet for us Catholics, we only have this beautiful Lazarus story once every three years in the season of Lent; and occasionally, at funeral services. Why do we reserve this most powerful proclamation only in Lent and at funerals? We need to proclaim that Jesus is the resurrection and the life NOT only in these moments, but in all moments of daily life.

IN CONCLUSION: I would say that much of our daily existence revolves around death. People eat healthy, exercise, buy life insurance—nothing bad about these things, by the way—... all because subconsciously, they have death in their minds. Ironic as it may sound, if we think about it, we realize that *death* does indeed play an essential role in our *living*. But not so with Jesus: he postpones his visit to his dying friend Lazarus, NOT because he does not care, but because he wants to relativize death. For the Lord, it is not death, but the resurrection and the life, that should have the last word. By not making death an absolute factor, Jesus opens for us a new way to view reality: the way of God's love, which is much stronger, more powerful, and certainly more deadly than death itself.

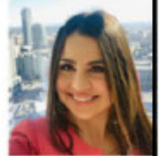
