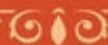

FATHER ANTHONY'S FAITH FORMATION CORNER

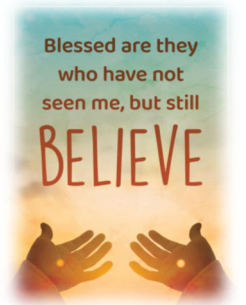
Public REVELATION and Private Revelations

In popular devotional Catholicism, the Second Sunday of Easter has recently been known as “Divine Mercy Sunday.” It is on this Sunday that I would like to explore the meaning of the word REVELATION in Catholic theology. In a broad sense, the word itself means God’s self-communication to humanity. In the past God has spoken to his people through the prophets. But in the “fullness of time,” God spoke to us through his own Son Jesus Christ. In our traditions, we say that Jesus is the fullness of God’s revelation, since he is the Word of God and the Truth of God. The closest disciples of Jesus, the Twelve Apostles, were the direct recipients of that revelation manifested in him. After his death and resurrection, they were to “hand down” to later generations of believers his teaching through their “apostolic preaching.” After their deaths the content of their oral teaching was preserved by the early Church in written documents; hence, the “scripture.” The ministry of the Apostles was continued by their successors, the bishops. Thus in our Catholic traditions we say that the bishops (the Pope being one of them) are the authentic teachers of the faith.

The content of this apostolic teaching came to be known as the *depositum fidei*: the deposit of the faith. That is what is meant by “public” revelation, which alone is important for our salvation. This stands in contrast to “private” revelations of this or that saint. The Church has never rejected private revelations. In fact, private revelations like those of St. Marie-Margaret Alacoque (17th cent) have always been important for the devotional life of the Church—the Sacred Heart of Jesus. But at the same time, these revelations do not propose any new doctrine: they may simply call special attention to matters that were already part of the *depositum fidei*... The same would apply for today’s devotion to the Divine Mercy, initiated by the Polish nun St. Faustina and confirmed by the late Pope John Paul II (also from Poland) in the early 2000’s.

Believers are NOT bound by any of these “private” revelations. While we are to adhere to doctrines such as the Incarnation or the Trinity (public), we do not have to hold as “divinely inspired” whatever certain saints had to say in their mystical experiences (private). One parishioner at a former church did ask me why we did not promote the Divine Mercy, as Jesus explicitly wished in his dialogue with Faustina. I would respond that our focus on the second Sunday of Easter, the last day of the Octave of Easter (the eight-day celebration from Easter Sunday to the second Sunday of Easter), revolves around the resurrection of Jesus—the supreme miracle of our faith. Whatever private revelations St. Faustina might have had can in no way eclipse the importance of the resurrection.

Similarly, a few years ago, I met a devout Vietnamese Catholic man who showed me some Youtube clips of a statue of the Blessed Mother crying in Vietnam. And he wondered why the bishops in Vietnam have been silent about it. He also said that no Vietnamese priest around here ever mentions it! I did not have the chance to properly catechize him about the complicated distinction between public and private revelations. But I did explain to him that the faithful are not required to adhere to any apparition of the Blessed Mother, even those officially sanctioned by the Church... In the end, I would say that devotions to the Blessed Mother, the Sacred Heart, the Divine Mercy, or any particular devotion, are great and they greatly enhance the faith: but the faithful should know that these do not constitute the essential aspect of our faith and worship. These devotions had their origins in certain private revelations, which are beautiful; but one can never overemphasize them that one forgets the more important public revelations which form the deposit of our faith.

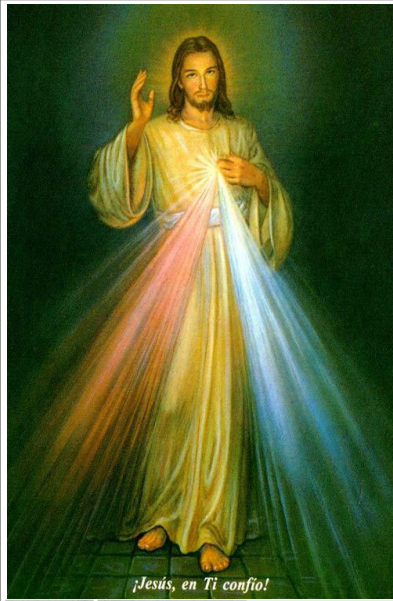

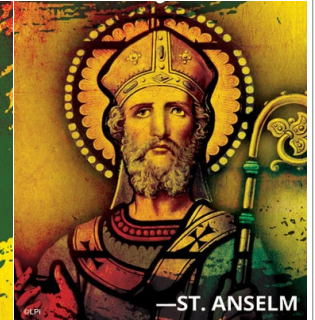

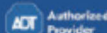
