GOSPEL MEDITATION

17th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Our culture seems more polarized and divided than ever. Into this wounded situation, our Catholic faith has a healing remedy to offer: the gift of wisdom. When the Lord offers to give King Solomon anything the monarch desires, he requests “an understanding heart” (1 Kings 3:9). In his polarized situation, the King doesn’t ask for power to defeat his enemies. He asks for a wise and understanding heart to judge right from wrong. This wisdom is elevated and fulfilled in Jesus who teaches us to bring forth “both the new and the old” (Matthew 13:52).

In our fractured society, we Christians should stop pining for political power to crush our perceived enemies. That often just makes things worse. Rather, it’s much more useful to beg for the grace of true wisdom which transcends both sides of the aisle. This places us in a fresh position from which we can help our culture see what is true and good all across the ideological spectrum. Sometimes we’ll look like liberals (e.g., in our love for the poor and marginalized) and other times like conservatives (e.g., in our sexual ethics and views on religious freedom). Because this wisdom is free from ideological narrowness, it will help to heal these painful fractures. Lord Jesus, this week, pour into us your healing wisdom. *Lpi*



The Falling Action and the Field

In my freshman year of high school, I was fairly miserable at identifying the five essential elements of plot (exposition, rising action, climax, falling action, and resolution).

To this day, the only reason I remember anything about them at all is because my English teacher used episodes of Scooby Doo to illustrate the different elements. Falling action vs. climax is where I got tripped up, the two are similar, and only discernible if you examine them relative to each other.

Every Scooby Doo episode has a big dramatic sequence (the climax) where the ghost/monster/zombie chases The Gang through the haunted mansion. The falling action is what comes immediately after: searching for her glasses that she lost during the chase, Velma bumps into a pulley wheel disguised behind a tapestry and realizes the ghost/monster/zombie is actually the janitor in a costume, hooked up to an elaborate cable system jerry-rigged throughout the mansion. Meddling kids. I confused the two because, to me, they are *both* equally dramatic: the chase and the fallout. It occurs to me that, if you look at the course of salvation history, we are living in the falling action, not the climax. Take the parable of the treasure in the field: we have found the treasure. But we haven’t yet bought the field. I often make the mistake of thinking I am still lost in the climax, searching for the truth. But I know exactly where the truth is.

What I need to be concerned with is this: am I doing what I need to do to buy the field?

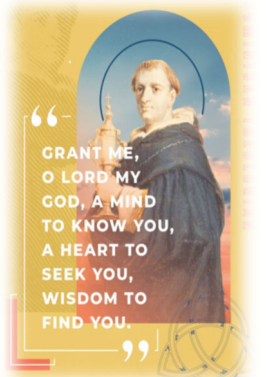

NƯỚC TRỜI LÀ CÓ THẬT**

“Nước Trời lại cũng giống như chuyện một thương gia đi tìm ngọc đẹp. Tìm được một viên ngọc quý, ông ta ra đi, bán tất cả những gì mình có mà mua viên ngọc ấy.” (Mt 13,45-46)

-Suy niệm: Trong đám tang những người ngoài Ki-tô giáo thường thấy có những bức liễn đề chữ “Vãng Sanh Cực Lạc”, ý nói cái chết là đi qua khỏi cuộc sống này về chốn hoàn toàn vui sướng hạnh phúc đời sau. Thế nhưng niềm tin ấy, đúng hơn, niềm ước mong đó, căn bản là mơ hồ, không xác định cõi cực lạc ấy như thế nào. Thế nên người ta vẫn sợ hãi cái chết và cố sức níu kéo để ở lại cõi trần này. Chúa Giê-su cho biết Nước Trời, chốn hạnh phúc mà con người hằng mơ ước đó, là điều có thật nhưng còn ẩn giấu, như viên ngọc quý, như *“kho báu chôn giấu trong ruộng”*. Nước Trời là có thật rất quý giá, nhưng phải nỗ lực tìm kiếm mới gặp được, hơn nữa, phải sẵn sàng hy sinh, đánh đổi mọi sự mình có mới có thể đạt tới được.

- Mối Ban: Nước Trời quý giá nhưng như viên ngọc quý ẩn khuất trong viên đá sù sì xấu xí, hay như kho tàng vô giá được chôn giấu trong đám ruộng tâm thường. Nước Trời đó thực ra không ở đâu xa, ngay trong gia đình với vợ chồng, con cái, nơi bạn làm việc học hành hằng ngày. Đó chính là kho báu bạn phải nỗ lực tìm kiếm và trân trọng giữ gìn.

- Sống Lời Chúa: *“Bán đi tất cả để mua viên ngọc Nước Trời”* đó là bạn từ bỏ những ham muốn ích kỷ, lợi ích cá nhân, những ý riêng của bạn để hết lòng phục vụ anh chị em mình.

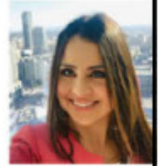
